PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

Students begin the program by setting goals for their entertainment broadcast, pertaining to how much profit they intend to make, satisfaction of viewers and effectiveness of marketing strategies.

Then, students identify and analyze their target market, in order to effectively develop content, implement marketing strategies and create a desirable viewer experience.

Throughout the program, students maintain a budget, which directly affects the development of their sponsorship proposals, complete with various price and benefit packages.

Students must also design and oversee logistics of the entertainment broadcast, including set-up, production and post show activities.

Finally, students analyze their success and failure as it relates to their goals established at the beginning of the program.
